

On November 24-26 2016 the G.S.A in collaboration with the National Archives of France (Archives Nationales -France) is co-organizing a Scientific Congress in Paris, under the general title: “*France-Greece: 1915-1995, archives, history, remembrance*” (included is the plan for the working sessions of the Congress).

The General State Archives (G.S.A) aided by the Ministry of Education, Research and Religious Affairs as well as the International Council on Archives (I.C.A) is represented by the following members of the G.S.A staff:

This specific action aims at exploring and promoting the existing relation between the two states for the aforementioned time period; with regard to the diplomatic, financial and political scene as observed through the study and research on archival material.

Following the working sessions of the Congress a corresponding Scientific Symposium will be held in Athens on December 21<sup>st</sup> 2016 in co-operation with the **French School at Athens** (*École française d’Athènes*).
