The General State Archives and the National Archives of France by virtue of the signature of Memorandum of Cooperation are organizing common scientific events. These events focus on the history of Hellenic-French relations in respect to the political, economic, institutional and cultural status during the period 1915-1995; through recitation and interpretation of the archival resources of both countries and the projection of audiovisual material the prominent spirit of the time-available in the archival collections-is brought out.

In accordance to this framework the National Archives of France have organized a Symposium in Paris, on November 24th -26th 2016, on “**France-Greece 1915-1995: archives, history, remembrance**”, with the contribution of French and Greek historians, archivists and prominent figures sharing their experience while shedding light on important events occurring during the period in question.

In response to the aforementioned scientific event, the General State Archives and the French School at Athens [(École Française d’Athènes (EFA))] are co-organizing a Symposium in **Athens, on December 21st 2016** bearing the same title, in the amphitheatre of the Athens French Institute.
